

Lk 2:21 And when eight days were completed for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb.

2:22 Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord

2:23 (as it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every male who opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord"),

2:24 and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, "A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons."

2:25 And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

2:26 And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

2:27 So he came by the Spirit into the temple. And when the parents brought in the Child Jesus, to do for Him according to the custom of the law,

2:28 he took Him up in his arms and blessed God and said:

2:29 "Lord, now You are letting Your servant depart in peace, According to Your word;

2:30 For my eyes have seen Your salvation

2:31 Which You have prepared before the face of all peoples,

2:32 A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people Israel."

2:33 And Joseph and His mother marveled at those things which were spoken of Him.

2:34 Then Simeon blessed them, and said to Mary His mother, "Behold, this Child is destined for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign which will be spoken against

2:35 "(yes, a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed."

2:36 Now there was one, Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of a great age, and had lived with a husband seven years from her virginity;

2:37 and this woman was a widow of about eighty-four years, who did not depart from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day.

2:38 And coming in that instant she gave thanks to the Lord, and spoke of Him to all those who looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

2:39 So when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own city, Nazareth.

2:40 And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him.

Good morning everyone. Happy New Year.

Last year, the infection of the several years continued without convergence, and there was a military invasion, and there was a high price... I hope this year will be a year full of peace and comfort.

Today, I would like to receive the teachings and vigor of the Lord from the deepest Simeon and Anna stories.

First of all, it is the figure of Joseph and Maria who advanced in today as it is written in the "law".

Live according to your word. This is the foundation of our lucky life.

At 2:25 there was a man named Simeon in Jerusalem. This man was a righteous man who longed for the comfort of Israel. And the Holy Spirit stayed with him.

2:26 and it was not until he saw the Savior of the Lord, that he did not die.

2:27 this man felt into the spirit and entered the palace. Then, in order to do what is prescribed in the law, his parents also took their son, Jesus.

2:28 Simeon held a young child in his arms, and praised him.

Simeon was a righteous person. It means that we live in the right relationship with God, and follow the standards, intentions and qualities of God. That Simeon had continued was the comfort of Israel in Japan. Comfort and help, peace and peace, and salvation and liberation. The Holy Spirit stayed with him, and he received the expression of the Holy Spirit, and he felt in the spirit and entered the palace. His life was in the heart of God. God was with righteous man, who lives in the right relationship with God, who obeys the standard of God, his will, and nature.

He had been shown by the Holy Spirit that he would not die until he met the Savior.

Until he sees the Savior, the Lord who sees death.

The reason for not dying until salvation is the death of the redeeming of the Lord Jesus and the salvation by the resurrection will no longer die, and in the end it will never die forever. Those who wait for the Lord will never be disappointed.

1 in the scripture 2:6 the Scripture says: "Behold, I will put on the Zion, the precious precious stone, the sheer stone in the corner, and the one who asks for it will never end in disappointment."

Isaiah 28:16 therefore, the LORD God said, "Behold, I put it on Zion: one stone, and it is a stone that has gone through a trial, a stone of a hard corner," the believers will not be haunted.

Those who believe in God and those who seek for their hearts will not experience disappointment or death. And there is guidance by the spirit of every day.

2:27 this man felt into the spirit and entered the palace. Then, in order to do what is prescribed in the law, his parents also took their son, Jesus.

2:28 Simeon held a young child in his arms, and praised him.

He held God's salvation in his arms. The Savior, the son of God's son, was certainly held in his arms. The spirit pointed to the Savior Christ. Even though he was unable to believe that the high priests and the scribes had seen Jesus' words and work many times, Simeon realized that he was the Messiah savior of God, who was not able to give up the spirit of the spirit to enter the palace, and yet to speak.

It is here that people live and live in God and live in the Holy Spirit.

2:29 "Lord, now, you will let me rest in this way:

"As you say,"

The man who has taken his life on his word and believed is not very disappointed. The life of the person who lives in the word is full, and it is in the certain protection, and the promise is fulfilled, and it doesn't end vacant. There is gratitude and peace, and there is a peaceful rest.

2:30 because my eyes have seen your salvation now.

My eyes saw your salvation.

Our eyes with God also see God's salvation. The promise of God's word will never end. Our faith may not be visible, but when time comes, it will certainly see salvation even in the visible form.

2:31 this salvation was prepared by the people,

2:32 "the light of revelation that illuminates the foreigner, the glory of Israel.

God and the Gentiles also made this salvation before the people.

The foreigner had revealed the glory of God in the light of revelation. That is the birth of this Savior.

2:33 father and mother wondered what was told about this young child.

2:34 and Simeon congratulated them and said to his mother Mariya, "see, this young child is set as a sign to oppose and stand against the many men of Israel --

2:35 and you will pierce your chest with a nail —— It is because the thought in the mind of many people appears.

Here is a little sinister and spooky prophecy.

This young child is laid down as a sign to oppose and stand many people in Israel.

Many people in Israel must be crushed. Because they had left the voice of the prophet because of arrogance, and left the voice of God. And fall, suffer, repentance, rise.

Jacob 1:9 brother of low status glad that he was raised.

1:10 but rich people may be glad that they were low. It is because the person who is rich passes away like a flower.

Luke 14:11 and the man who raises himself becomes low, and the man who lowers himself will be raised.

1 as for Peter 5: 5, young people. Obey the elders. In addition, make humility. For he has blessed the sweltering man, and he bestowed grace on the servant.

5:6 thou shalt be beneath God's mighty hand. God will raise you.

5:7 because God is holding you up, you may put your own thoughts to God.

Jesus was a son of God, but he was betrayed himself, and he was really cross to the cross.

Billiard 2:6 Christ is made by God's form, but it is not thought that he should obey the fact that it is equal to God

2:7 And I took my form in the form of a human being. That way is different from others

2:8 it was obedient until death, and to the death of the cross.

2:9 God raised him high and gave him a name over all his name.

2:10 according to the name of Jesus, everything in the heavens, the earth, the ground, and so on, lay down his knees;

2:11 And every tongue shall confess, "Jesus Christ is the Lord," and to give glory to God the father.

Jesus fell and resurrected. Jesus was jealous, hated, and opposed to many people, standing on the arrowhead, and his heart passed through suffering and grief. It would have been for Mary —— It is because the thought in the heart of many people appears. In order to realize that the thought of the heart is evil, Jesus made the way of solitude and sorrow.

Isa53:1 Who has believed our report?And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?

53:2 For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him.

53:3 He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.

53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

53:7 He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth.

53:8 He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

53:9 And they made His grave with the wicked - But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth.

53:10 Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand.

53:11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.

53:12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.

2:36 she was a daughter of Panelle of the asel family, and there was a woman prophet named Anna. She was very old. She lived with her husband for seven years

2:37 he was killed and was eighty-four years old. And he served God with fasting and prayers at night and day.

Although it may be said that he was married at the age of 15 and died in seven years, and the husband dies early in the late twenties, it may be said that it is too light, but this is a story of 2000 years ago. It was not unusual that he died in his twenties and thirties.

It is said that it was the blessing of the amazing God that the person named Anna lived in this age to 84, even if it was Simeon. I wonder if they were dead. They must have been in the eyes of many people who prayed at the age and prayed in the palace.

"He was serving God with fasting and prayers at night and day without leaving the temple. Anna's concern was to pray and pray and keep serving God. In his lifetime God gave grace of longevity and health. He gave me a mission.

2:38 and this old woman came up just now and thanked him, and spoke to all the people waiting for the rescue of Jerusalem.

Anna also knew what this event was. And how wonderful the plan of God in this young child Jesus spoke to everyone who waited for the salvation of Jerusalem.

From the chapel of Chapel Chapter 11, verse 11, "the brethren have given up to him by the blood of the lamb and the words of their blessings, and have given up their lives until death."

We redeem by the blood of the lamb, and in the love of God's overwhelming forgiveness, we witness the event. Lead to death through life throughout the lifetime. It does not spare the life, and it doesn't spare time, and the thing is poured there without spare passion. The person in the destination is a strong charm and blessing of God.

2:39 as he had done all the things of the Lord, he went to Galilee and returned to his town Nazareth.

According to the law of the Lord, as the word of the Scripture, the life of the Lord's will to live for today.

2:40 young children grew more and more strong, full of wisdom, and God's grace on it.

The infant Jesus grew more and more strong, full of wisdom, and God's grace on it. And we believe in God. I have strength. There is wisdom and insight by the Holy Spirit. Ask by God's grace and continue this year.

2 Corinth: 4:15 all things are of you, and as grace grows to more and more people, gratitude is full of glory, and glory of God.

4:16 we are not discouraged. Even if our people perish, the inner will be renewed every day.

4:17 because this light of light for a long time will work, and we will get eternal everlasting glory.

4:18 we pour our eyes into what is invisible. What is visible is temporary, and what is not visible will follow forever.

2 Corinth 6:2 God said, "I have heard your wishes at the time of grace, and helped you on the day of salvation. Behold, now is the time of grace, and now is the day of salvation.

6:3 we will not give any stumbling to the people, for this service does not lead us to the passage;

6:4 and in every case, I express myself to the people of God. In other words, extreme pain, suffering, crisis, and deadlock

6:5 it was a hit, a prison, a disturbance, an effort, a night, and hunger

6:6 truth, knowledge, tolerance, love, the Holy Spirit and love without false

6:7 by the words of the truth and the power of God, by the arms of righteousness

6:8 even if I am praised, or even if I receive a bad reputation, I will show myself as a god of me even if I receive a good reputation. We seem to be confused, but it is true;

6:9 it seems that it is not known, but it is acknowledged, and it is death, but it looks, is alive, and is punished, but it is not killed

6:10 it seems to be sad, but it is always delighted, and seems poor, but seems to have many things, and it does not have anything, but has everything.

Prayer; Thank God for the heavenly Father today. When we lose our place, when we are lost, when we are lost, when we are lost, we still have a place where we can escape, there is a place for pleasure, a time for pleasure, and God's nourishment.
