

Lk 2:41 His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover.

2:42 And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast.

2:43 When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it;

2:44 but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances.

2:45 So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him.

2:46 Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.

2:47 And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.

2:48 So when they saw Him, they were amazed; and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously."

2:49 And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?"

2:50 But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them.

2:51 Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart.

2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

Good morning everyone.

There was snow in the morning yesterday, but I was relieved that it was snowy compared with the cold wave with Christmas.

Coming of age ceremony tomorrow. From April of last year, the age of the adult was lowered, and it became adult from 18 years old. Compared to 20 years old and 20 years old, I feel 20 years old now. 4:15 all things are of you, and as grace grows to more and more people, it is full of gratitude and glory of God.

4:16 we are not discouraged. Even if our people perish, the inner will be renewed every day.

4:17 because this light of light for a long time will work, and we will get eternal everlasting glory.

4:18 we pour our eyes into what is invisible. What is visible is temporary, and what is not visible will follow forever.
