

Lk22:31 And the Lord said, "Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat.

22:32 "But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren."

22:33 But he said to Him, "Lord, I am ready to go with You, both to prison and to death."

22:34 Then He said, "I tell you, Peter, the rooster shall not crow this day before you will deny three times that you know Me."

22:35 And He said to them, "When I sent you without money bag, knapsack, and sandals, did you lack anything?" So they said, "Nothing."

22:36 Then He said to them, "But now, he who has a money bag, let him take it, and likewise a knapsack; and he who has no sword, let him sell his garment and buy one.

22:37 "For I say to you that this which is written must still be accomplished in Me: 'And He was numbered with the transgressors.' For the things concerning Me have an end."

22:38 So they said, "Lord, look, here are two swords." And He said to them, "It is enough."

22:39 Coming out, He went to the Mount of Olives, as He was accustomed, and His disciples also followed Him.

22:40 When He came to the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation."

22:41 And He was withdrawn from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and prayed,

22:42 saying, "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

22:43 Then an angel appeared to Him from heaven, strengthening Him.

22:44 And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

22:45 When He rose up from prayer, and had come to His disciples, He found them sleeping from sorrow.

22:46 Then He said to them, "Why do you sleep? Rise and pray, lest you enter into temptation."

Good morning everyone.

I went on to progress in the time of the passion clause, and went to the place of the Passion Week next week.

After the last supper, the army of the man who captures the Lord, Jesus, tried to enclose his

disciples, and said Jesus prayed to his disciples.

Matthew 26:31 then Jesus said to his disciples, "you will stumble upon me tonight, because I have written the shepherd, and the flock of sheep will be scattered.

Zechariah 13:7 says the Lord of the seven thousand armies, "thou shalt stand up and attack my pastor, and shoot the next man, and shoot the pastor, and the sheep shall be scattered, and I will hold my hand and attack the little.

31 Simon, Simon, and Satan were forgiven to wield you as muddy.

32 but I prayed for you not to lose your faith. So, when you get back, force your brothers.

Satan, the devil says, as if he knew that he was nothing but a valuable husk. "Let God behold his disciples like wheat," let him pass, pass, or test as his disciple. Will they pass as the disciple of the Lord? The LORD God has accepted the offer.

When it sits, the light rice husks fly away with the wind, but the wheat with a solid fruit falls on the spot. Now, will the disciples sweep away like the husks that blow away?

"I prayed for you not to lose your faith," which implies that it is a great event that the disciples can lose faith.

33 Simon said, "Lord, I will go to the prison and death, I will go with you."

Simon Peter told me that in this speech of Jesus, the heavenly thing of Jesus will come to an end, and how fierce persecution will come, "Lord, I will be prepared to go to the prison and to death."

But Jesus answered this word.

34 and Jesus said, "Peter, tell you, today, till the chickens cry, you will not know me three times."

When the dinner was over and the night went away, there was a serious happening in the night, and the night of the same night, this evening, before the dawn of the night, now I say, "Lord, I will be ready to go to the prison and to death," and just as the tongue of the tongue is dry. Peter told us that three times before he could hear the early rising of the chickens, he did not have anything to do with it. What did Peter think about this word of Jesus? I think that the feeling that the unbelievable feeling, such a thing could never be, was not shaken.

35 and they said to them, "did I have anything to do with you when I did not have any purse, bag or purse?" They answered, "no, nothing."

36 but said, "now that you have the purse, take it, and take the bag as well, and the wicked man will sell his coat and buy it.

37 but you must be made to me that he is counted as one of the sins. Yes, it is fulfilled.

38 and the disciples said, "Lord, here are two twists." Jesus said, "that's good."

It is said that the Lord Jesus is like a criminal and is pulled violently. After that, there may be danger to the disciples. There might be many people who accepted and supported because it was Jesus's disciple. But from now on, he might fear the persecution and be torn apart by the disciples of Jesus. The weapon is threatened, attacked, and blood may flow. I had no purse, bag, and weapon. However, the situation changes from now on. The Lord told me, "what is known to him as one of the sins has to be made to me, and that I have fulfilled my actions."

39 and Jesus went out and went to Mt. OriB as usual, and his disciples followed.

40 they said to them, "pray not to fall into temptation".

41 and as he threw away the stone, he withdrew, kneeling, and prayed,

42 "if you are a father, please take this cup from me, but please don't be my thought, but be sure to come in.

43 then the angel appeared from heaven to force Jesus.

44 Jesus was suffering, and he prayed more and more. And the sweat fell to the ground like blood.

45 when he stood up and stood up, and went to his disciples, he saw them lying in grief

46 said, "why do you sleep? Don't fall into temptation, and pray."

"Pray not to be tempted," "I prayed for you not to lose your faith."

"Jesus was suffering and he was prayed more and more."

"My envoy appeared from heaven and forced him."

They fall asleep in sadness. "Why don't you sleep? Don't fall into temptation."

Today's place is wonderful of prayer.

Jesus prayed all the time. Jesus was the best about the severity of the situation. When the siege is narrower and the enemy's hand is about to reach it.

"If you are a father, please take this cup away from me," and there was a figure of Jesus who prayed to pray for the pain of his sweat to fall like a blood. Jesus himself was in the test to be chased before his disciples. At the beginning of his official life, following the temptation of the three degrees of wilderness, at the end of his life there was a fierce demon's struggle and attempt. Now, with his own thoughts, throw away the bitter cup, and the devil whispers that it will be easy. But Jesus prayed, "but not my thought, please let me know."

We are weak. A strong determination is, if it is determined by our own power, soon deconstructed. But if there is a prayer there. We know that our weakness and unhappiness are we disqualified. It is a disqualification who blows it if it sits. But if we do, we will wait for your help, and cry for prayer. When Jesus was calling the Gentiles outside the criminal and the law, and tried to abandon it, and tried to be crucified, he prayed with great suffering, and was searched for God. And the support in the prayer was obtained, and the power was obtained.

How do we catch the prayer? There are various things to know about our wishes, to get peace. What is taught here is the way that prayer can be an urgent help at the moment of difficulty and even now deconstructed. It is far from the imagination that the fierce difficulty of trying to fuss and attempt to surround the situation, and to try to fail against us, will fail.

"Take this cup away from me," and there may be a strain on us so that we can't bear it any more. It may be because of our weakness. It may be difficult for the poor suffering of those

who did not commit sin like Jesus. But in any way, in the situation where we try to chase us against disadvantages, the only way to win is to pray in the temptation to lose faith.

Simon was the original name, and Peter was the name Jesus named in the meaning of "rock".

It was the first time that this was called after Luke Chapter 5, after the miracle of the great catch, that Peter was a sinful person.

Lk 5:1 So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret,

5:2 and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets.

5:3 Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat.

5:4 When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch."

5:5 But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net."

5:6 And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking.

5:7 So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they

came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink.

5:8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!"

5:9 For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken;

5:10 and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men."

5:11 So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.

I am weak or weak Simon, my beloved son Simon, I pray for you.

33 Simon said, "Lord, I will go to the prison and death, I will go with you."

34 and Jesus said, "Peter, tell you, today, till the chickens cry, you will not know me three times."

I know your hard determination. But people are not so strong. I know at last. You know from suffering, from regret, from the repentance, in the prayers, standing up, and coming back. It is strong when it is weak. It was Peter, who knew the weakness and the ugliness of God, and the strength of God. At this time, I pray that you will not lose faith, but also recognize your weakness, stains and ugliness, and stand up for God's mercy and forgiveness before God. And you will stand up, help others, and force and encourage our brothers, and the voice of the Lord is ringing in our hearts. We also hope that there is a world of prayer to overcome our weaknesses, and that we are supported by a tight situation of fear of blood dripping, and that the source of encouragement is prayer, and we go forward with prayer.

Prayer; Thank God for the heavenly Father today. It is taught that man's power and will, the disciples, and the purity of our faith, are pure and fragile. Thank you for your determination and our failure to make a great mistake, but to be protected by the Lord's prayer, and to pray to God, to answer and pray to us. Protect us from temptation, and never let us stand by ourselves in the circumstances that surround us, but let us tell you that we can face through the power and grace of God, and help us to continue praying without despair.
